



Pay It Fur-Ward Pet Safety Pocket Checklist

Love Without Judgment

Daily Food & Water

- Pack measured pet food portions in sealed bags.
- Offer fresh water often and carry a collapsible bowl.
- Increase hydration during hot weather.

Shelter & Comfort

- Keep bedding elevated and dry whenever possible.
- Provide shade in heat and wind protection in cold.
- Use coats/blankets for short-haired or senior pets.

Basic First Aid

- Gauze / vet wrap
- Saline or wound wash
- Tweezers
- Pet-safe antiseptic wipes
- Emergency transport/vet contact information

Daily Safety Check

- Inspect paws/body for cuts, burns, foxtails, or swelling.
- Watch for overheating, shivering, lethargy, vomiting, or labored breathing.
- Seek veterinary care immediately for serious injury or illness.
